- AN ACT Relating to nursing assistants; amending RCW 74.46.240;
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 18.88A RCW; and adding a new section to
- 3 chapter 18.51 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 18.88A RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) A nursing assistant employed by a nursing home, who has 8 satisfactorily completed an omnibus budget reconciliation act (OBRA) 9 approved nursing assistant training program under this chapter, shall, 10 upon application to the department of social and health services, be 11 issued a certificate of completion within thirty calendar days of
- 12 submitting the application.
- 13 (2) Nursing assistants employed by a nursing home must show 14 evidence of satisfactory completion of an omnibus budget reconciliation
- 15 act (OBRA) approved nursing assistant training program, or that they
- 16 are enrolled in and are progressing satisfactorily towards completion
- 17 of an omnibus budget reconciliation act (OBRA) approved training
- 18 program under standards adopted by the department of social and health
- 19 services. An omnibus budget reconciliation act (OBRA) approved

- 1 training program must be satisfactorily completed within six months of
- 2 initial employment. A nursing home may employ a person not currently
- 3 enrolled if the employer within twenty days enrolls the person in an

- 5 however a nursing home may not assign an assistant to provide resident
- 6 care until the assistant has demonstrated skills necessary to perform

- 17 training directly related to the performance of duties assigned will be
- 18 allowable costs. <u>No costs may be allowed for an omnibus budget</u>

- 20 where the training program requires trainees to attend and complete
- 21 training without receiving compensation as provided in RCW 74.46.430.
- 22 (2) Necessary and ordinary expenses of recreational and social
- 23 activity training conducted by the contractor for volunteers will be

- 25 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 18.51 RCW
- 26 to read as follows:
- 27 Compliance with section 1 of this act is a condition of licensure
- 28 under this chapter.
