- 1 AN ACT Relating to oil spill response accounts; and amending RCW 2 90.56.510.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 90.56.510 and 1993 c 162 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

(1) The oil spill administration account is created in the state

- 7 treasury. All receipts from RCW 82.23B.020(2) shall be deposited in 8 the account. Moneys from the account may be spent only after 9 appropriation. The account is subject to allotment procedures under
- 10 chapter 43.88 RCW. On July 1 of each odd-numbered year, if receipts
- 11 described in the consent from the test invested by DCM 00 22D 020/2) for
- 11 deposited in the account from the tax imposed by RCW 82.23B.020(2) for
- 12 the previous fiscal biennium exceed the amount appropriated from the
- 13 account for the previous fiscal biennium, the state treasurer shall 14 transfer the amount of receipts exceeding the appropriation to the oil
- 15 spill response account. If, on the first day of any calendar month,
- 16 the balance of the oil spill response account is greater than twenty-
- 17 five million dollars and the balance of the oil spill administration
- 18 account exceeds the unexpended appropriation for the current biennium,
- 19 then the tax under RCW 82.23B.020(2) shall be suspended on the first

- 1 day of the next calendar month until the beginning of the following
- 2 biennium, provided that the tax shall not be suspended during the last
- 3 six months of the biennium. If the tax imposed under RCW 82.23B.020(2)
- 4 is suspended during two consecutive biennia, the department shall by
- 5 November 1st after the end of the second biennium, recommend to the
- 6 appropriate standing committees an adjustment in the tax rate. For the
- 7 ((period 1991-93)) biennium ending June 30, 1995, the state treasurer
- 8 may transfer funds from the oil spill response account to the oil spill
- 9 administration account in amounts necessary to support appropriations
- 10 made from the oil spill administration account in the ((omnibus))
- 11 supplemental appropriations act adopted not later than June 30, 1994.
- 12 (2) Expenditures from the oil spill administration account shall be
- 13 used exclusively for the administrative costs related to the purposes
- 14 of this chapter, and chapters 90.48, 88.40, and 88.46 RCW. Starting
- 15 with the 1995-1997 biennium, the legislature shall give activities of
- 16 state agencies related to prevention of oil spills priority in funding
- 17 from the oil spill administration account. Costs of administration
- 18 include the costs of:
- 19 (a) Routine responses not covered under RCW 90.56.500;
- 20 (b) Management and staff development activities;
- 21 (c) Development of rules and policies and the state-wide plan
- 22 provided for in RCW 90.56.060;
- 23 (d) Facility and vessel plan review and approval, drills
- 24 inspections, investigations, enforcement, and litigation;
- 25 (e) Interagency coordination and public outreach and education;
- 26 (f) Collection and administration of the tax provided for in
- 27 chapter 82.23B RCW; and
- 28 (g) Appropriate travel, goods and services, contracts, and
- 29 equipment.
