- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 90.48 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) If the department adopts rules for permits for storm water 7 discharges under this chapter or under the federal clean water act it 8 shall establish only one set of standards for control of storm water 9 discharges.
- 10 (2) If the department adopts rules establishing standards for sediment quality control and sediment source control, it shall establish only one set of standards for sediment source control and sediment quality control for permits for storm water discharges. The standards shall allow the same time period for compliance with the standards for all discharges, whether publicly or privately owned or operated.
- 17 (3) If the department adopts rules establishing sediment quality 18 standards for marine or fresh waters, and by rule authorizes the 19 establishment of a dilution zone, the department shall not authorize a
