- 6 RCW 28A.210.310 and 1989 c 233 s 6 are each amended to Sec. 3. 7 read as follows:
- 8 PROHIBITION ON USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS ON SCHOOL PROPERTY. protect children in the public and private schools of this state from 9 exposure to the addictive substance of nicotine and cancer-causing 10 agents found in environmental tobacco smoke, each school or school 11 12 district ((board of directors)) shall adopt a written policy mandating a prohibition on the use of all tobacco products on ((public)) school 13 14 property. A total ban on the use of all tobacco products shall be enforced by September 1, 1991((. The policy may allow for exemptions 15 from this prohibition with regard to alternative educational 16 programs)), for public schools and September 1, 1994, for private 17 schools. Schools shall make available tobacco cessation information 18 and referral to students in violation of this section, in coordination
