- AN ACT Relating to forests; amending RCW 76.04.455; and prescribing

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 76.04.455 and 1986 c 100 s 29 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) It is unlawful during the closed season for any person to throw 7 away any lighted tobacco, cigars, cigarettes, matches, fireworks,
- 8 charcoal, or other lighted material or to discharge any tracer or
- 9 incendiary ammunition in any forest, brush, range, or grain areas.
- 10 (2) It is unlawful during the closed season for any individual to
- 11 smoke any flammable material when in forest or brush areas except on
- 12 roads, cleared landings, gravel pits, or any similar area free of
- 13 flammable material.
- 14 (3) Every conveyance operated through or above forest, range,
- 15 brush, or grain areas shall be equipped in each compartment with a
- 16 suitable receptacle for the disposition of lighted tobacco, cigars,
- 17 cigarettes, matches, or other flammable material.
- 18 (4) Every person operating a public conveyance through or above
- 19 forest, range, brush, or grain areas shall post a copy of this section

- 1 in a conspicuous place within the smoking compartment of the
- 2 conveyance; and every person operating a saw mill or a logging camp in
- 3 any such areas shall post a copy of this section in a conspicuous place
- 4 upon the ground or buildings of the milling or logging operation.
- 5 A person violating this section is guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
