- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 81.72 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 The legislature recognizes that the use of alternative fuels in

motor vehicles contributes to improved air quality. Taxicab companies

- 8 with fleets using alternative fuels will help the state meet its clean
- o with freets using afternative ruers will help the state meet its crean
- 9 air goals by operating cleaner burning vehicles and providing, or
- 10 supporting the development of, refueling stations for alternative
- 11 fuels. The development of these refueling stations may encourage

greater use of alternative fuels by publicly and privately owned

- 13 vehicles, and help state and local governments meet federal, state, and
- 14 local mandates requiring the use of alternative fuels for vehicle
- 15 fleets. Therefore, political subdivisions that regulate taxicab
- 16 transportation are encouraged to include among their licensees, when
