- 1 AN ACT Relating to enforcement of plumbing certificate of
- 2 competency requirements; amending RCW 18.106.020, 18.106.180, and
- 3 18.106.270; adding a new section to chapter 18.106 RCW; repealing RCW
- 4 18.106.025; and prescribing penalties.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 18.106 RCW
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 The department may enter into agreements with political
- 9 subdivisions of the state regarding compliance inspections by the
- 10 political subdivision to enforce this chapter. The political
- 11 subdivision may be permitted, under the terms of the agreement, to
- 12 submit declarations of noncompliance to the department for the
- 13 department's enforcement under RCW 18.106.180.
- 14 Sec. 2. RCW 18.106.020 and 1983 c 124 s 4 are each amended to read
- 15 as follows:
- 16 (1) No person may engage <u>in or offer to engage</u> in the trade of
- 17 plumbing without having a journeyman certificate, or specialty
- 18 certificate, temporary permit, or without being supervised by a person

- 1 who has a journeyman certificate, specialty certificate, or temporary
- 2 permit. No person may employ a person to engage in or offer to engage
- 3 in the trade of plumbing unless the person employed has a journeyman
- 4 <u>certificate</u>, <u>specialty certificate</u>, <u>or temporary permit or is</u>
- 5 supervised by a person who has a journeyman certificate, specialty
- 6 <u>certificate</u>, <u>or temporary permit</u>.
- 7 (2) Violation of subsection (1) of this section is an infraction.
- 8 Each day in which a person engages in the trade of plumbing in
- 9 violation of subsection (1) of this section or employs a person in
- 10 violation of subsection (1) of this section is a separate infraction.
- 11 Each worksite at which a person engages in the trade of plumbing in
- 12 <u>violation of subsection (1) of this section or at which a person is</u>
- 13 <u>employed in violation of subsection (1) of this section is a separate</u>
- 14 infraction.
- 15 (3) Notices of infractions for violations of subsection (1) of this
- 16 section may be issued to:
- 17 (a) The person engaging in or offering to engage in the trade of
- 18 plumbing in violation of subsection (1) of this section;
- 19 <u>(b) The employer of a person employed in violation of subsection</u>
- 20 (1) of this section; and
- 21 <u>(c) The employer's supervisor who authorized the work assignment of</u>
- 22 the person employed in violation of subsection (1) of this section.
- 23 **Sec. 3.** RCW 18.106.180 and 1983 c 124 s 7 are each amended to read
- 24 as follows:
- 25 An authorized representative of the department may issue a notice
- 26 of infraction as specified in RCW 18.106.020(3) if a person who is
- 27 doing plumbing work or who is offering to do plumbing work fails to
- 28 produce evidence of having a certificate or permit issued by the
- 29 department in accordance with this chapter or of being supervised by a
- 30 person who has such a certificate or permit. A notice of infraction
- 31 issued under this section shall be personally served on the person
- 32 named in the notice by an authorized representative of the department.
- 33 **Sec. 4.** RCW 18.106.270 and 1983 c 124 s 16 are each amended to
- 34 read as follows:
- 35 (1) A person found to have committed an infraction under RCW
- 36 18.106.020 shall be assessed a monetary penalty of ((one)) two hundred
- 37 fifty dollars for the first infraction, and not more than one thousand

- 1 <u>dollars for a second or subsequent infraction. The department shall</u>
- 2 set by rule a schedule of penalties for infractions imposed under this
- 3 <u>chapter</u>.
- 4 (2) The court may waive, reduce, or suspend the monetary penalty
- 5 imposed for the infraction for good cause shown.
- 6 (3) Monetary penalties collected under this chapter shall be 7 remitted as provided in chapter 3.62 RCW.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** RCW 18.106.025 and 1983 c 124 s 5 are each 9 repealed.
