- 1 AN ACT Relating to dental licensure reciprocity; and amending RCW 2 18.32.215.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.32.215 and 1989 c 202 s 30 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 An applicant holding a valid license and currently engaged in
- 7 practice in another state may be granted a license without examination
- 8 required by this chapter, on the payment of any required fees, if the
- 9 board determines that the other state's licensing standards are
- 10 substantively equivalent to the standards in this state, and finds that
- 11 the other state either has entered into a reciprocal protocol with the
- 12 <u>board for licensing Washington dentists under substantively similar</u>
- 13 conditions, or otherwise provides by law for the licensing of out-of-14 state dentists without examination by endorsement or credentials:
- 15 PROVIDED, That the board may require the applicant to: (1) File with
- 16 the board documentation certifying the applicant is licensed to
- 17 practice in another state; and (2) provide information as the board
- 18 deems necessary pertaining to the conditions and criteria of the
- 19 uniform disciplinary act, chapter 18.130 RCW and to demonstrate to the
