1 AN ACT Relating to cigarette vending machines; and amending RCW  
2 70.155.030.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.155.030 and 1993 c 507 s 4 are each amended to read  
5 as follows:

6 No person shall sell or permit to be sold any tobacco product  
7 through any device that mechanically dispenses tobacco products unless  
8 the device is located fully within premises from which minors are  
9 prohibited or in industrial worksites where minors are not employed and  
10 not less than ten feet from all entrance or exit ways to and from each  
11 premise(~~s~~). The board shall adopt rules that allow an exception to  
12 the requirement that a device be located not less than ten feet from  
13 all entrance or exit ways to and from a premise if it is  
14 architecturally impractical for the device to be located not less than  
15 ten feet from all entrance and exit ways.
