- 1 AN ACT Relating to operational flexibility of institutions of
- 2 higher education; and amending RCW 28B.50.330, 28B.10.350, and
- 3 43.88.150.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.50.330 and 1993 c 379 s 108 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 The boards of trustees of college districts are empowered in
- 8 accordance with the provisions of this chapter to provide for the
- 9 construction, reconstruction, erection, equipping, demolition, and
- 10 major alterations of buildings and other capital assets, and the
- 11 acquisition of sites, rights-of-way, easements, improvements, or
- 12 appurtenances for the use of the aforementioned colleges as authorized
- 13 by the college board in accordance with RCW 28B.50.140; to be financed
- 14 by bonds payable out of special funds from revenues hereafter derived
- 15 from income received from such facilities, gifts, bequests, or grants,
- 16 and such additional funds as the legislature may provide, and payable
- 17 out of a bond retirement fund to be established by the respective
- 18 district boards in accordance with rules and regulations of the state
- 19 board. With respect to building, improvements, or repairs, or other

work, where the estimated cost exceeds ((twenty-five)) fifty thousand dollars, complete plans and specifications for such work shall be 2 prepared and such work shall be put out for public bids and the 3 4 contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder if in accordance with the bid specifications: PROVIDED, That when such 5 building, construction, renovation, remodeling, or demolition involves 6 7 one trade or craft area and the estimated cost exceeds ((ten)) twenty-8 five thousand dollars, complete plans and specifications for such work 9 shall be prepared and such work shall be put out for public bids, and 10 the contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder if in accordance with the bid specifications. 11 This subsection shall not apply when a contract is awarded by the small works procedure 12 13 authorized in RCW 39.04.150: PROVIDED FURTHER, That any project regardless of dollar amount may be put to public bid. 14

19 **Sec. 2.** RCW 28B.10.350 and 1993 c 379 s 109 are each amended to 20 read as follows:

Where the estimated cost to any college of any building,

improvements, or repairs, or other work, is less than ((twenty five))

fifty thousand dollars, the publication requirements of RCW 39.04.020

(1) When the cost to The Evergreen State College, any regional 21 university, or state university, of any building, construction, 22 23 renovation, remodeling, installation, or demolition other than 24 maintenance or repairs will equal or exceed the sum of ((twenty five)) 25 fifty thousand dollars, complete plans and specifications for such work shall be prepared and such work shall be put out for public bids and 26 the contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder if in 27 accordance with the bid specifications: PROVIDED, That when the 28 29 estimated cost of such building, construction, renovation, remodeling, 30 installation, or demolition equals or exceeds the sum of ((twentyfive)) fifty thousand dollars, such project shall be deemed a public 31 works and "the prevailing rate of wage," under chapter 39.12 RCW shall 32 33 be applicable thereto: PROVIDED FURTHER, That when such building, 34 construction, renovation, remodeling, installation, or demolition involves one trade or craft area and the estimated cost exceeds ((ten)) 35 36 twenty-five thousand dollars, complete plans and specifications for 37 such work shall be prepared and such work shall be put out for public bids, and the contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsible 38

- (2) The Evergreen State College, any regional university, or state university may require a project to be put to public bid even when it is not required to do so under subsection (1) of this section.
- (3) Where the estimated cost to The Evergreen State College, any regional university, or state university of any building, construction, renovation, remodeling, <u>installation</u>, or demolition is less than ((twenty-five)) <u>fifty</u> thousand dollars or the contract is awarded by the small works procedure authorized in RCW 28B.10.355, the publication requirements of RCW 39.04.020 shall be inapplicable.
- 13 (4) In the event of any emergency when the public interest or property of The Evergreen State College, regional university, or state 14 15 university would suffer material injury or damage by delay, the 16 president of such college or university may declare the existence of 17 such an emergency and reciting the facts constituting the same may waive the requirements of this section with reference to any contract 18 19 in order to correct the condition causing the emergency: PROVIDED, That an "emergency," for the purposes of this section, means a 20 condition likely to result in immediate physical injury to persons or 21 to property of such college or university in the absence of prompt 22 23 remedial action or a condition which immediately impairs 24 institution's ability to perform its educational obligations.
- 25 **Sec. 3.** RCW 43.88.150 and 1991 c 284 s 3 are each amended to read 26 as follows:
- 27 (1) For those agencies that make expenditures from both 28 appropriated and nonappropriated funds for the same purpose, the 29 governor shall direct such agencies to charge their expenditures in 30 such ratio, as between appropriated and nonappropriated funds, as will 31 conserve appropriated funds.
 - (2) Unless otherwise provided by law, if state moneys are appropriated for a capital project and matching funds or other contributions are required as a condition of the receipt of the state moneys, the state moneys shall be disbursed in proportion to and only to the extent that the matching funds or other contributions have been received and are available for expenditure.

- 1 (3) The office of financial management shall adopt guidelines for 2 the implementation of this section. The guidelines may account for 3 federal matching requirements or other requirements to spend other 4 moneys in a particular manner.
- 5 (4) Operating fees of the community and technical colleges, The 6 Evergreen State College, regional universities, and state universities 7 are exempted from the provisions of this section.
