- 1 AN ACT Relating to on-site sewage disposal; adding new sections to
- 2 chapter 70.118 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 54.16 RCW; and
- 3 creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** It is the intent of the legislature to
- 6 encourage the use of properly designed, installed, and operating on-
- 7 site sewage systems appropriate for the local soil conditions, which
- 8 are cost-effective and environmentally sound means of sewage disposal.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 70.118 RCW
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 An on-site sewage disposal system appropriate for the local soil
- 12 conditions that is designed by a professional engineer and installed
- 13 under the direct supervision of a professional engineer shall be deemed
- 14 to meet requirements and standards for on-site sewage disposal systems
- 15 that are established by the department of health and local board of
- 16 health.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 70.118 RCW
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 Local boards of health are encouraged to implement programs
- 4 involving the periodic monitoring and inspection of on-site sewage
- 5 disposal systems to ensure the adequate maintenance and operation of
- 6 these systems, and including the imposition of fees necessary to
- 7 finance these monitoring and inspection costs.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 70.118 RCW
- 9 to read as follows:
- 10 Counties, sewer districts, public utility districts, and other
- 11 municipal corporations that provide sewerage utilities are encouraged
- 12 to provide and operate properly designed and operating on-site sewage
- 13 disposal systems as a cost-effective and environmentally sound means of
- 14 sewage disposal.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** A new section is added to chapter 54.16 RCW
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 The authority of a public utility district to provide sewerage
- 18 systems includes on-site sewage disposal systems that are appropriate
- 19 for local soil conditions on the site.
