- 1 AN ACT Relating to waiver of injunction bonds if a person's health
- 2 or life would be jeopardized; and amending RCW 7.40.080.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 7.40.080 and 1957 c 51 s 9 are each amended to read as follows:
- 6 No injunction or restraining order shall be granted until the party
- 7 asking it shall enter into a bond, in such a sum as shall be fixed by
- 8 the court or judge granting the order, with surety to the satisfaction
- 9 of the clerk of the superior court, to the adverse party affected
- of the citik of the superior court, to the diverse party directed
- 10 thereby, conditioned to pay all damages and costs which may accrue by
- 11 reason of the injunction or restraining order. The sureties shall, if
- 12 required by the clerk, justify as provided by law, and until they so
- 13 justify, the clerk shall be responsible for their sufficiency. The
- 14 court in its sound discretion may waive the required bond in situations
- 15 in which a person's health or life would be jeopardized.
