- 1 AN ACT Relating to the prohibition of nondegradable beverage
- 2 container connectors; and amending RCW 70.132.030.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.132.030 and 1982 c 113 s 3 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) No person may sell or offer to sell at retail in this state any
  7 beverage container so designed and constructed that a metal part of the
  8 container is detachable in opening the container through use of a metal
  9 ring or tab. Nothing in this section prohibits the sale of a beverage
  10 container which container's only detachable part is a piece of pressure
- 11 sensitive or metallic tape.
- 12 (2) No person may sell or offer for sale at retail in this state
- 13 metal beverage containers connected to each other by a separate holding
- 14 device constructed of plastic rings or other material that will not
- 15 <u>decompose</u> by <u>photobiodegradation</u>, <u>chemical degradation</u>, <u>or</u>
- 16 biodegradation within one hundred twenty days of disposal.
