NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives, 9 10 the Senate concurring, That all bills, joint resolutions, joint memorials, and concurrent resolutions introduced in the 1993 regular 11 12 session and the 1993 special session of the Fifty-third Legislature are reintroduced in the house in which they originated and shall retain the 13 14 same number and be given the legislative status that they held in the 15 original house as shown by the official House and Senate dockets upon the adjournment SINE DIE of the 1993 special session. 16
