1 BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives, the Senate 2 concurring, that the Joint Legislative Systems Committee shall provide 3 members of the public with electronic access to public legislative 4 information such as bills, bill digests, bill reports, and resolutions. In carrying out this responsibility the committee shall consider: 5 The various data bases and documents maintained on the legislative б 7 information system; the desire by members of the public for electronic access; the method and format best suited for providing public access; 8 the need to provide the most current and accurate information; the 9 educational purpose that would be served by granting public access; the 10 need to maintain the integrity and security of the legislative computer 11 12 system; the capital and operating costs of providing public access; and the desirability of providing access at no cost or lowest cost possible 13 to the general public. By October 1, 1994, the committee shall have 14 15 adopted a plan for carrying out this rule.
