1 AN ACT Relating to funding for the state auditor's office; amending
2 RCW 43.09.230; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.09.270 and 1991 sp.s. c 16 s 920 are each amended
5 to read as follows:

6 The expense of maintaining and operating the division (~~shall be~~
7 ~~paid out of the state general fund: PROVIDED, That~~) of municipal
8 corporations and those expenses directly related to the prescribing of
9 accounting systems, training, maintenance of working capital including
10 reserves for late and uncollectable accounts and necessary adjustments
11 to billings, and field audit supervision, shall be considered as
12 expenses of auditing public accounts within the meaning of RCW
13 43.09.280 and 43.09.282, and shall be prorated for that purpose equally
14 among all entities directly affected by such service.

15 (~~During the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 1993, the expense of~~
16 ~~maintaining and operating the division of municipal corporations shall~~
17 ~~be paid from the municipal revolving fund under RCW 43.09.282.))~~

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
2 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
3 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
4 effect July 1, 1993.
