- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 18.74 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The department, upon approval by the board, shall issue an
- 8 interim permit authorizing an applicant for licensure who meets the
- 9 minimum qualifications stated in RCW 18.74.030 to practice physical
- 10 therapy under graduate supervision pending notification of the results
- 11 of the first licensure examination for which the applicant is eligible,
- 12 but not to exceed six months.
- 13 (2) For purposes of this section, "graduate supervision" means
- 14 supervision of a holder of an interim permit by a licensed physical
- 15 therapist who is on the premises at all times. Graduate supervision
- 16 shall include consultation regarding evaluation, treatment plan,
- 17 treatment program, and progress of each assigned patient at appropriate
- 18 intervals and be documented by cosignature of notes by the licensed

- 1 physical therapist. RCW 18.74.012 is not applicable for holders of
- 2 interim permits.
- 3 (3) If the holder of the interim permit fails the examination, the 4 permit expires upon notification and is not renewable.
- 5 **Sec. 2.** RCW 18.74.029 and 1987 c 150 s 47 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 The uniform disciplinary act, chapter 18.130 RCW, governs
- 8 unlicensed practice, the issuance and denial of licenses and interim
- 9 permits, and the discipline of licensees and holders of interim permits
- 10 under this chapter.

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
