- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 39.84.130 and 1981 c 300 s 13 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 No part of the proceeds received from the sale of any revenue bonds
- 7 under this chapter, of any revenues derived from any industrial
- 8 development facility acquired or held under this chapter, or of any
- 9 interest realized on moneys received under this chapter may be
- 10 commingled by the public corporation with funds of the municipality
- 11 creating the public corporation. <u>However, those funds of the public</u>
- 12 corporation, other than proceeds received from the sale of revenue
- 13 bonds, that are not otherwise encumbered for the payment of revenue
- 14 bonds and are not reasonably anticipated by the board of directors to
- 15 be necessary for administrative expenses of the public corporation may
- 16 be transferred to the creating municipality and used for growth
- 17 management, planning, or other economic development purposes.
