1 AN ACT Relating to notification to employees of ability to restore
2 withdrawn retirement system contributions; adding a new section to
3 chapter 41.50 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 41.40 RCW; and
4 creating a new section.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 41.50 RCW
7 to read as follows:

8 (1) The director shall notify a member of any of the retirement
9 systems listed in RCW 41.50.030 who is eligible to restore withdrawn
10 contributions of the member's ability to restore the contributions, by
11 sending to the member's employer a statement of the potential service
12 credit to be restored, the amount of funds required for restoration,
13 the date by when the restoration must be accomplished, and the options
14 for repayment. The employer shall provide the statement to the member
15 and place a copy of the statement in the member's personnel file.

16 (2) Neither this section nor any other provision in this chapter or
17 chapter 41.26, 41.32, 41.40, 41.54, or 43.43 RCW authorize the
18 extension of statutory restore deadlines for members who do not receive
19 notice of their eligibility to restore withdrawn contributions. This

1 subsection applies retroactively to restoration periods which expired
2 prior to the effective date of this act.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 41.40 RCW,
4 under the subchapter heading "plan I," to read as follows:

5 Any active member or separated member who was not eligible to
6 restore contributions under section 3, chapter 317, Laws of 1986,
7 solely because he or she was an elected official, other than an elected
8 official under Articles II or III of the Constitution of the state of
9 Washington, shall be permitted to restore withdrawn contributions for
10 periods of nonelected service no later than June 30, 1994, with
11 interest as determined by the director.

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** If specific funding for the purposes of this
13 act, referencing this act by bill number, is not provided by June 30,
14 1993, in the biennial appropriations act, this act shall be null and
15 void.

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
