- AN ACT Relating to elections in cities with a commission plan of
- 2 government; and amending RCW 35.17.020.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 35.17.020 and 1979 ex.s. c 126 s 17 are each amended 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) All regular elections in cities organized under the statutory
- 7 commission form of government shall be held quadrennially in the odd-8 numbered years on the dates provided in RCW 29.13.020. <u>However, after</u>
- 9 commissioners are elected at the next general election occurring in
- 10 1995 or 1997, regular elections in cities organized under a statutory
- 11 commission form of government shall be held biennially at municipal
- 12 general elections.
- 13 (2) The commissioners shall be nominated and elected at large.
- 14 Their terms shall be for four years and until their successors are
- 15 elected and qualified and assume office in accordance with RCW
- 16 29.04.170. However, at the next regular election of a city organized
- 17 under a statutory commission form of government, the terms of office of
- 18 commissioners shall occur with the person who is elected as a
- 19 commissioner receiving the least number of votes being elected to a

- 1 two-year term of office and the other two persons who are elected being
- 2 <u>elected to four-year terms of office</u>. Thereafter, commissioners shall
- 3 <u>be elected to four-year terms of office.</u>
- 4 (3) If a vacancy occurs in the commission the remaining members
- 5 shall appoint a person to fill it for the unexpired term.
