1            BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives, the Senate  
2 concurring, that the Joint Legislative Systems Committee shall provide  
3 members of the public with electronic access to public legislative  
4 information such as bills, bill digests, bill reports, and resolutions.  
5 In carrying out this responsibility the committee shall consider: The  
6 various data bases and documents maintained on the legislative  
7 information system; the desire by members of the public for electronic  
8 access; the method and format best suited for providing public access;  
9 the need to provide the most current and accurate information; the  
10 educational purpose that would be served by granting public access; the  
11 need to maintain the integrity and security of the legislative computer  
12 system; the capital and operating costs of providing public access; and  
13 the desirability of providing access at no cost or lowest cost possible  
14 to the general public. By October 1, 1994, the committee shall have  
15 adopted a plan for carrying out this rule.

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
