- 1 AN ACT Relating to hazing at state and independent institutions of
- 2 higher education; adding new sections to chapter 28B.10 RCW; and
- 3 prescribing penalties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 As used in sections 2 and 3 of this act, "hazing" includes any
- 8 method of initiation into a student organization or living group, or
- 9 any pastime or amusement engaged in with respect to such an
- 10 organization or living group that causes, or is likely to cause, bodily
- 11 danger or physical harm to any student or other person attending a
- 12 public or private institution of higher education or other
- 13 postsecondary educational institution in this state. The term "hazing"
- 14 does not include customary athletic events or other similar contests or
- 15 competitions.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 RCW
- 17 to read as follows:

p. 1 SB 5075

- 1 No student, or other person in attendance at any public or private
- 2 institution of higher education, or any other postsecondary educational
- 3 institution, may conspire to engage in hazing, participate in hazing,
- 4 or commit an act that injures, degrades, or disgraces, or tends to
- 5 injure, degrade, or disgrace any fellow student or person attending the
- 6 institution.
- 7 A violation of this section is a misdemeanor, punishable under RCW
- 8 9.92.030, by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars, or
- 9 imprisonment in the county jail for not more than ninety days, or both.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 RCW
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 A person who participates in the hazing of another, or any
- 13 organization, association, or student living group that knowingly
- 14 permits hazing to be conducted by its members or by others subject to
- 15 its direction or control, shall forfeit any entitlement to public
- 16 funds, scholarships, or awards and shall be deprived of any sanction,
- 17 official recognition, or approval granted by a public institution of
- 18 higher education.
- 19 The public institutions of higher education shall adopt rules to
- 20 implement this section.
