1 AN ACT Relating to the western Washington upland game bird permit;
2 and amending RCW 77.32.350.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.32.350 and 1992 c 41 s 1 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 In addition to a basic hunting license, a supplemental license,
7 permit, or stamp is required to hunt for quail, partridge, pheasant, or
8 migratory waterfowl, to hunt with a raptor, or to hunt wild animals
9 with a dog.

10 (1) A hound permit is required to hunt wild animals, except rabbits
11 and hares, with a dog. The fee for this permit is twelve dollars.

12 (2) An eastern Washington upland game bird permit is required to
13 hunt for quail, partridge, and pheasant in eastern Washington. The fee
14 for this permit is ten dollars.

15 (3)(a) A western Washington upland game bird permit is required to
16 hunt for quail, partridge, and pheasant in western Washington. ((The
17 fee for this permit is thirty-five dollars.)) Western Washington
18 upland game bird permits must contain numbered spaces for recording the
19 location and date of harvest of each western Washington pheasant. It

1 is unlawful to harvest a western Washington pheasant without
2 immediately recording this information on the permit.

3 ~~((4))~~ ~~Effective January 1, 1993,~~) (b) The western Washington
4 upland game bird permit shall be available as a season option, a
5 juvenile full season option, or a two-day option. The fee for this
6 permit is:

7 ~~((a))~~ (i) For the full season option, ~~((thirty-five))~~ twenty
8 dollars;

9 ~~((b))~~ (ii) For the juvenile full season or the two-day option,
10 ~~((twenty))~~ ten dollars.

11 For the purposes of this subsection a juvenile is defined as a
12 person under fifteen years of age upon the opening date of the western
13 Washington pheasant season.

14 ~~((5))~~ (c) Western Washington upland game permits are valid for
15 the following number of pheasants and harvesting pheasants in excess of
16 these numbers requires another permit:

17 ~~((a))~~ (i) A full season permit is valid for no more than ten
18 pheasants;

19 ~~((b))~~ (ii) A juvenile full season permit is valid for no more
20 than six pheasants;

21 ~~((c))~~ (iii) A two-day permit is valid for no more than four
22 pheasants.

23 ~~((6))~~ (4) A falconry license is required to possess or hunt with
24 a raptor, including seasons established exclusively for hunting in that
25 manner. The fee for this license is thirty-six dollars.

26 ~~((7))~~ (5) A migratory waterfowl stamp affixed to a basic hunting
27 license is required for all persons sixteen years of age or older to
28 hunt migratory waterfowl. The fee for the stamp is six dollars.

29 ~~((8))~~ (6) The migratory waterfowl stamp shall be validated by the
30 signature of the licensee written across the face of the stamp.

31 ~~((9))~~ (7) The migratory waterfowl stamps required by this section
32 expire on March 31st following the date of issuance.
