- 1 AN ACT Relating to the western Washington upland game bird permit;
- 2 and amending RCW 77.32.350.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.32.350 and 1992 c 41 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 In addition to a basic hunting license, a supplemental license,
- 7 permit, or stamp is required to hunt for quail, partridge, pheasant, or
- 8 migratory waterfowl, to hunt with a raptor, or to hunt wild animals
- 9 with a dog.
- 10 (1) A hound permit is required to hunt wild animals, except rabbits
- 11 and hares, with a dog. The fee for this permit is twelve dollars.
- 12 (2) An eastern Washington upland game bird permit is required to
- 13 hunt for quail, partridge, and pheasant in eastern Washington. The fee
- 14 for this permit is ten dollars.
- 15 (3)(a) A western Washington upland game bird permit is required to
- 16 hunt for quail, partridge, and pheasant in western Washington. ((The
- 17 fee for this permit is thirty-five dollars.)) Western Washington
- 18 upland game bird permits must contain numbered spaces for recording the
- 19 location and date of harvest of each western Washington pheasant. It

- 1 is unlawful to harvest a western Washington pheasant without 2 immediately recording this information on the permit.
- 3 ((<del>(4)</del> Effective January 1, 1993,)) (b) The western Washington 4 upland game bird permit shall be available as a season option, a 5 juvenile full season option, or a two-day option. The fee for this 6 permit is:
- 7  $((\frac{a}{a}))$  (i) For the full season option,  $(\frac{thirty-five}{a})$  twenty 8 dollars;
- 9 ((<del>(b)</del>)) <u>(ii)</u> For the juvenile full season or the two-day option, 10 ((<del>twenty</del>)) <u>ten</u> dollars.
- 11 For the purposes of this subsection a juvenile is defined as a 12 person under fifteen years of age upon the opening date of the western 13 Washington pheasant season.
- 14 ((<del>(5)</del>)) <u>(c)</u> Western Washington upland game permits are valid for 15 the following number of pheasants and harvesting pheasants in excess of 16 these numbers requires another permit:
- 17  $((\frac{a}{a}))$  <u>(i)</u> A full season permit is valid for no more than ten 18 pheasants;
- 19  $((\frac{b}{b}))$  (ii) A juvenile full season permit is valid for no more 20 than six pheasants;
- 21 (((c))) (iii) A two-day permit is valid for no more than four 22 pheasants.
- $((\frac{(6)}{(6)}))$  (4) A falconry license is required to possess or hunt with a raptor, including seasons established exclusively for hunting in that manner. The fee for this license is thirty-six dollars.
- $((\frac{7}{1}))$  (5) A migratory waterfowl stamp affixed to a basic hunting license is required for all persons sixteen years of age or older to hunt migratory waterfowl. The fee for the stamp is six dollars.
- (((8))) (6) The migratory waterfowl stamp shall be validated by the signature of the licensee written across the face of the stamp.
- $((\frac{9}{}))$  The migratory waterfowl stamps required by this section expire on March 31st following the date of issuance.
