- 1 AN ACT Relating to limits on phosphorus contents in certain
- 2 detergents; and adding new sections to Title 70 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature hereby finds and declares 5 that:
- 6 (1) Phosphorus loading of surface waters can stimulate the growth 7 of weeds and algae, and that such growth can have adverse 8 environmental, health, and aesthetic effects;
- 9 (2) Household and commercial detergents contribute to phosphorus 10 loading, and that a limit on detergents containing phosphorus can 11 significantly reduce the discharge of phosphorus into the state's 12 surface and ground waters;
- (3) Household and commercial detergents containing no or very low phosphorus are readily available and that over thirty percent of the United States population lives in areas with a ban on detergents containing phosphorus; and
- 17 (4) Phosphorus limits on household and commercial detergents can 18 significantly reduce treatment costs at those sewage treatment 19 facilities that remove phosphorus from the waste stream.

- 1 It is therefore the intent of the legislature to impose a state-
- 2 wide limit on the phosphorus content of household and commercial
- 3 detergents.
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** Unless the context clearly requires
- 5 otherwise, the definitions in this section apply throughout sections 1
- 6 through 4 of this act.
- 7 (1) "Department" means the department of ecology.
- 8 (2) "Dishwashing detergent" means a cleaning agent sold, used, or
- 9 manufactured for the purpose of cleaning dishes, whether by hand or by
- 10 household or commercial machine.
- 11 (3) "Laundry detergent" means a cleaning agent sold, used, or
- 12 manufactured for the purpose of cleaning laundry, whether by hand or by
- 13 household or commercial machine.
- 14 (4) "Person" means an individual, firm, association, copartnership,
- 15 political subdivision, government agency, municipality, industry,
- 16 public or private corporation, or any other entity whatsoever.
- 17 (5) "Phosphorus" means elemental phosphorus.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. (1) After October 1, 1993, a person may not
- 19 use, sell, or distribute a laundry detergent that contains 0.5 percent
- 20 or more phosphorus by weight.
- 21 (2) A person may not use, sell, or distribute a dishwashing
- 22 detergent that contains (a) after October 1, 1993, 8.7 percent or more
- 23 phosphorus by weight and (b) after October 1, 1995, 6 percent or more
- 24 phosphorus by weight.
- 25 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** The department is responsible for notifying
- 26 major distributors and wholesalers of the state-wide limit on
- 27 phosphorus in detergents.
- 28 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** Sections 1 through 4 of this act are each
- 29 added to Title 70 RCW.
