- 1 AN ACT Relating to employment benefits for employees under school
- 2 service contracts; and adding a new section to Title 28A RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to Title 28A RCW to 5 read as follows:
- 6 (1) Each contract for the purchase of services by a school district
- 7 board of directors or an educational service district superintendent 8 executed after the effective date of this section shall require the
- 9 contractor to provide health care and retirement benefits to all
- 10 employees who are performing services under the contract that were
- 11 previously performed by classified school employees. The contract
- 12 shall require the health care and retirement benefits to be
- 13 commensurate with the health care and retirement benefits provided by
- 14 the school district or educational service district to classified
- 15 employees performing services similar to those services being performed
- 16 under the contract.
- 17 (2) This section does not apply to:
- 18 (a) Temporary, nonongoing, or nonrecurring service contracts; or

- 1 (b) Contracts for services previously performed by employees in 2 director/supervisor, professional, and technical positions.
  - (3) For the purposes of subsection (2) of this section:

- (a) "Director/supervisor position" means a position in which an employee directs staff members and manages a function, a program, or a support service.
- 7 (b) "Professional position" means a position for which an employee 8 is required to have a high degree of knowledge and skills acquired 9 through a baccalaureate degree or its equivalent.
- 10 (c) "Technical position" means a position for which an employee is 11 required to have a combination of knowledge and skills that can be 12 obtained through approximately two years of posthigh school education, 13 such as from a community or technical college, or by on-the-job 14 training.
