1 AN ACT Relating to operation of overweight loads; and amending RCW
2 46.44.0941.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.44.0941 and 1990 c 42 s 107 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 The following fees, in addition to the regular license and tonnage
7 fees, shall be paid for all movements under special permit made upon
8 state highways. All funds collected, except the amount retained by
9 authorized agents of the department as provided in RCW 46.44.096, shall
10 be forwarded to the state treasury and shall be deposited in the motor
11 vehicle fund:

12	All overlegal loads, except overweight, single trip . . .	\$ 10.00
13	Continuous operation of overlegal loads having either	
14	overwidth or overweight features only, for a period	
15	not to exceed thirty days	\$ 20.00
16	<u>Continuous operation of overlegal loads consisting only</u>	
17	<u>of empty fruit bins and having overweight</u>	
18	<u>features only, for a three-month period</u>	<u>\$ 60.00</u>

1	<u>Continuous operation of overlegal loads consisting only</u>	
2	<u>of empty fruit bins and having overheight</u>	
3	<u>features only, for a period of one year</u>	<u>\$ 240.00</u>
4	Continuous operations of overlegal loads having overlength	
5	features only, for a period not to exceed thirty	
6	days	\$ 10.00
7	Continuous operation of a combination of vehicles having	
8	one trailing unit that exceeds forty-eight feet and	
9	is not more than fifty-six feet in length, for a	
10	period of one year	\$100.00
11	Continuous operation of a combination of vehicles having	
12	two trailing units which together exceed sixty feet	
13	and are not more than sixty-eight feet in length,	
14	for a period of one year	\$100.00
15	Continuous operation of a three-axle fixed load vehicle	
16	having less than 65,000 pounds gross weight, for a	
17	period not to exceed thirty days	\$ 70.00
18	Continuous operation of overlegal loads having	
19	nonreducible features not to exceed eighty-five feet	
20	in length and fourteen feet in width, for a period	
21	of one year	\$150.00

22 Continuous operation of farm implements under a permit issued as
23 authorized by RCW 46.44.140 by:

24	(1) Farmers in the course of farming activities, for any	
25	three-month period	\$ 10.00
26	(2) Farmers in the course of farming activities, for a	
27	period not to exceed one year	\$ 25.00
28	(3) Persons engaged in the business of the sale, repair,	
29	or maintenance of such farm implements, for any	
30	three-month period	\$ 25.00
31	(4) Persons engaged in the business of the sale, repair,	
32	or maintenance of such farm implements, for a period	
33	not to exceed one year	\$100.00

22 PROVIDED: (a) The minimum fee for any overweight permit shall be
 23 \$ 14.00, (b) the fee for issuance of a duplicate permit shall be
 24 \$ 14.00, (c) when computing overweight fees that result in an amount
 25 less than even dollars the fee shall be carried to the next full dollar
 26 if fifty cents or over and shall be reduced to the next full dollar if
 27 forty-nine cents or under.
