- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 10.64 RCW
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Within fourteen days of the entry of a judgment of conviction of an
- 8 individual for an infamous crime, the clerk of the court shall send a
- 9 notice of the conviction including the full name of the defendant and
- 10 his or her residential address to the county auditor or custodian of
- 11 voting records in the county of the defendant's residence.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 29.10 RCW
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 Upon receiving notice under section 1 of this act, if the convicted
- 15 person is a registered voter in the county, the county auditor or

- 1 custodian of voting records shall strike the name of the defendant from
- 2 the role of registered voters.
