## SECOND SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 5514

State of Washington 53rd Legislature 1993 Regular Session

- 1 AN ACT Relating to economic development grants; adding new sections
- 2 to chapter 43.41 RCW; and creating new sections.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that state-supported
- 5 economic development efforts, including work force training, technology
- 6 transfer, and industrial modernization, can make a significant
- 7 difference in the health and diversification of the state's economy.
- 8 There are numerous federal and private economic development grant
- 9 programs and research projects designed to increase the competitiveness
- 10 of American firms and local work forces, for which state agencies and
- 11 local consortiums are eligible to apply. The legislature further
- 12 finds that state agencies in Washington have not maximized the
- 13 opportunities available to them to facilitate the receipt of federal
- 14 and private funds by Washington firms, nor have they maximized the
- 15 opportunities available to receive federal funds directly to augment
- 16 state economic development efforts.
- 17 The legislature declares that it is the state's policy to maximize
- 18 the use of federal and private funds for economic development purposes
- 19 and to devote state resources to leverage federal and private dollars

- 1 to supplement state economic development efforts. In furtherance of
- 2 this policy, it is the purpose of section 2 of this act to authorize
- 3 and fund a technical assistance and grant writing program within the
- 4 office of financial management.

- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.41 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- The economic development grants program is created in the office of 8 financial management. The program shall be operated by a managing 9 director with the support of at least one grant writer either on 10 contract or on staff. The managing director shall:
- 11 (1) Regularly review the federal register for opportunities to 12 apply for grants, research projects, and demonstration projects;
  - (2) Stay abreast of grant opportunities with private foundations;
- (3) Correspond and meet with federal officials, including those in the small business administration, the department of labor, the department of commerce, and the department of health and human services, as well as foundation officials, on the prospects for obtaining federal and private funds for economic development purposes in Washington state;
- (4) Work with the agency heads and division directors of the departments of trade and economic development, the employment security department, the department of agriculture, the department of community development, the Washington technology center, and other state agencies as appropriate, to apprise them of the opportunities for federal and private grant dollars for economic development projects;
- (5) Work with business, labor, and community groups to apprise them of the opportunities for federal and private grant dollars for economic development projects via publications, electronic bulletin boards, or toll-free phone lines;
- (6) Assist state agencies in their grant-seeking efforts for economic development projects. Grant writing for and assistance in grant writing for projects sponsored or cosponsored by state agencies shall be the highest priority of the program's work;
- 34 (7) Assist local business, labor, and community consortiums in 35 their grant-seeking efforts for economic development projects.
- 36 (8) Facilitate coordination and linkages between agencies and 37 between local consortiums and state agencies that will increase the 38 likelihood of success in grant seeking; and

- 1 (8) Garner the political support necessary from federal and state 2 elected and appointed officials for success in grant seeking.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 43.31 RCW 4 to read as follows:
- 5 The department shall ensure that the business assistance center,
- 6 the small business development centers, and the associate development
- 7 organizations that operate under the authority of the department notify
- 8 their constituencies and clients of the availability of the technical
- 9 assistance services of the economic development grants program created
- 10 in section 2 of this act.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** If specific funding for the purposes of this
- 12 act, referencing this act by bill number, is not provided by June 30,
- 13 1993, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act is null and void.
