34 **Sec. 2.** RCW 48.48.065 and 1986 c 266 s 72 are each amended to read
35 as follows:

36 (1) The chief of each organized fire department, or the sheriff or
37 other designated county official having jurisdiction over areas not
38 within the jurisdiction of any fire department, shall report

1 statistical information and data to the director of community
2 development, through the director of fire protection, on each fire
3 occurring within the official's jurisdiction. Reports shall be
4 consistent with the national fire incident reporting system developed
5 by the United States fire administration and rules established by the
6 director of community development, through the director of fire
7 protection. The director of community development, through the
8 director of fire protection, and the department of natural resources
9 shall jointly determine the statistical information to be reported on
10 fires on land under the jurisdiction of the department of natural
11 resources.

12 (2) The director of community development, through the director of
13 fire protection, shall analyze the information and data reported,
14 compile a report, and distribute a copy annually by January 31 to each
15 chief fire official in the state. Upon request, the director of
16 community development, through the director of fire protection, shall
17 also furnish a copy of the report to any other interested person at
18 cost. The report shall be annually cross-checked against the
19 statistical information collected by the arson alarm foundation or
20 other similar insurance industry arson information register.

21 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** The department of community development,
22 through the division of fire protection, shall study and compile a
23 report on the feasibility of implementing an arson protection program.
24 The division of fire protection shall assess methods for screening
25 potential future arsonists among children, the benefit in arson
26 prevention of the treatment of children prone to firesetting, and the
27 value of compiling and maintaining a data base of the profiles of young
28 firesetters. The division shall include in the study the examination
29 of current state and local prevention programs, including the King
30 county juvenile firesetters program. The department of community
31 development shall deliver the report by December 1, 1993.

32 **Sec. 4.** RCW 48.48.140 and 1991 c 154 s 1 are each amended to read
33 as follows:

34 (1) Smoke detection devices shall be installed inside all dwelling
35 units:

36 (a) Occupied by persons other than the owner on and after December
37 31, 1981; or

1 (b) Built or manufactured in this state after December 31, 1980.

2 (2) The smoke detection devices shall be designed, manufactured,
3 and installed inside dwelling units in conformance with:

4 (a) Nationally accepted standards; and

5 (b) As provided by the administrative procedure act, chapter 34.05
6 RCW, rules and regulations promulgated by the director of community
7 development, through the director of fire protection.

8 (3) Installation of smoke detection devices shall be the
9 responsibility of the owner. Maintenance of smoke detection devices,
10 including the replacement of batteries where required for the proper
11 operation of the smoke detection device, shall be the responsibility of
12 the tenant, who shall maintain the device as specified by the
13 manufacturer. At the time of a vacancy, the owner shall insure that
14 the smoke detection device is operational prior to the reoccupancy of
15 the dwelling unit.

16 (4) Any owner or tenant failing to comply with this section (~~shall~~
17 ~~be punished by a fine of not more than two hundred dollars~~) is guilty
18 of a misdemeanor.

19 (5) For the purposes of this section:

20 (a) "Dwelling unit" means a single unit providing complete,
21 independent living facilities for one or more persons including
22 permanent provisions for living, sleeping, eating, cooking, and
23 sanitation; and

24 (b) "Smoke detection device" means an assembly incorporating in one
25 unit a device which detects visible or invisible particles of
26 combustion, the control equipment, and the alarm-sounding device,
27 operated from a power supply either in the unit or obtained at the
28 point of installation.

29 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** The sum of _____ dollars, or as much
30 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium ending
31 June 30, 1995, from the general fund to the department of community
32 development for the purposes of the study under section 3 of this act.

33 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 6.** This act is necessary for the immediate
34 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the

1 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
2 effect immediately.

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
