- 1 AN ACT Relating to proof of insurance for vehicle registration; and
- 2 amending RCW 46.16.040 and 46.16.210.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.16.040 and 1987 c 244 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 Application for original vehicle license shall be made on ((<del>[a]</del>))
- 7 <u>a</u> form furnished for the purpose by the department. Such application
- 8 shall be made by the owner of the vehicle or duly authorized agent over
- 9 the signature of such owner or agent, and the applicant shall certify
- 10 that the statements therein are true to the best of the applicant's
- 11 knowledge. The application must show:
- 12 (1) Name and address of the owner of the vehicle and, if the
- 13 vehicle is subject to a security agreement, the name and address of the
- 14 secured party;
- 15 (2) Trade name of the vehicle, model, year, type of body, the
- 16 identification number thereof;
- 17 (3) The power to be used--whether electric, steam, gas or other
- 18 power;

- 1 (4) The purpose for which said vehicle is to be used and the nature 2 of the license required;
- (5) The licensed gross weight for such vehicle which in the case of for hire vehicles and auto stages with seating capacity of more than six shall be the adult seating capacity thereof, including the operator, as provided for in RCW 46.16.111. In the case of motor trucks, tractors, and truck tractors, the licensed gross weight shall be the gross weight declared by the applicant pursuant to the provisions of RCW 46.16.111;
- 10 (6) The unladen weight of such vehicle, if it be a motor truck or 11 trailer, which shall be the shipping weight thereof as given by the 12 manufacturer thereof unless another weight is shown by weight slip 13 verified by a certified weighmaster, which slip shall be attached to 14 the original application;
- 15 (7) Such other information as shall be required upon such 16 application by the department.
- The application must be accompanied by written proof that the owner of the vehicle is covered by liability insurance or other financial responsibility in accordance with chapter 46.30 RCW.
- 20 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.16.210 and 1977 c 8 s 1 are each amended to read as 21 follows:
  - (1) Upon receipt of the application and proper fee for original vehicle license, the director shall make a recheck of the application and in the event that there is any error or omission in the application it may be returned to the county auditor or other agent to effectively secure the correction of such error or omission, who shall return the same corrected to the director.
- (2) Application for the renewal of a vehicle license shall be made 28 29 to the director or his agents, including county auditors, by the registered owner on a form prescribed by the director. The application 30 must be accompanied by (a) the certificate of registration for the last 31 registration period in which the vehicle was registered in Washington 32 unless the applicant submits a preprinted application mailed from 33 34 Olympia, (b) written proof that the registered owner of the vehicle is covered by liability insurance or other financial responsibility in 35 accordance with chapter 46.30 RCW, and (c) the payment of such license 36 fees and excise tax as may be required by law. Such application shall 37 be handled in the same manner and the fees transmitted to the state 38

2 Any such application which upon validation becomes a renewal

certificate need not have entered upon it the name of the lien holder,

(3) Persons expecting to be out of the state during the normal 5 forty-five day renewal period of a vehicle license may secure renewal 6 of such vehicle license for a period of thirty days prior thereto and 7 8 have license plates or tabs preissued by making application to the 9 director or his agents upon forms prescribed by the director. 10 application must be accompanied by the certificate of registration for the last registration period in which the vehicle was registered in 11 Washington and be accompanied by such license fees, including a special 12 handling fee of two dollars; one dollar to be retained by the issuing 13 agency, and one dollar to be deposited in the highway safety fund, and 14 15 excise tax as may be required by law.

(4) Application for the annual renewal of a vehicle license number plate to the director or his agents shall not be required for those vehicles owned, rented, or leased by the state of Washington, or by any county, city, town, school district, or other political subdivision of the state of Washington.
