- 1 AN ACT Relating to school-based budgeting based on the
- 2 characteristics and educational needs of students; and creating a new
- 3 section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** During the 1994-95 school year, the
- 6 superintendent of public instruction shall require any school district
- 7 with an enrollment of more than forty thousand students in the 1994-95
- 8 school year to develop and implement a budget system that allocates
- 9 resources based on the characteristics and the educational needs of the
- 10 students, including but not limited to factors such as poverty, single-
- 11 parent households, eligibility for bilingual education, and low
- 12 performance on assessments, in each school before the superintendent of
- 13 public instruction allocates any funds for nonbasic education programs
- 14 to the school district.
