3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.76.020 and 1975 1st ex.s. c 260 s 9A.76.020 are
5 each amended to read as follows:

6 ~~((Every person who, (1) without lawful excuse shall refuse or~~
7 ~~knowingly fail))~~ It is unlawful for a person to make a willfully
8 untrue, misleading, or ((furnish any)) exaggerated statement((, report,
9 or information lawfully required of him by a public servant, or (2) in
10 any such statement or report shall make any knowingly untrue statement
11 to a public servant, or (3) shall knowingly)) to a law enforcement
12 officer, or to willfully hinder, delay, or obstruct ((any public
13 servant)) a law enforcement officer in the discharge of his or her
14 official powers or duties((; shall be)). A person who violates this
15 section is guilty of a misdemeanor.
