- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 (1) A person who is an elected or appointed state official may not
- 12 be beneficially interested, directly or indirectly, in any personal
- 13 services contract with any agency.
- 14 (2) As used in this section:
- 15 (a) "Agency" means all state agencies and all local agencies.
- 16 "State agency" includes every state office, department, division,
- 17 bureau, board, commission, or other state agency.

- 1 (b) "Local agency" includes every county, city, town, municipal corporation, quasi-municipal corporation, or special purpose district, or any office, department, division, bureau, board, commission, or agency thereof, or other local public agency.
- 5 (c) "Personal services" means professional or technical expertise 6 provided by a consultant to accomplish a specific study, project, task, 7 or other work statement.
- 8 (d) "Personal services contract" means an agreement, or any 9 amendment thereto, with a consultant for the rendering of personal 10 services to an agency.
