- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 43.09.300 and 1988 c 53 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 There shall be in the office of the state auditor a division to be
- 7 known as the division of departmental audits. The state auditor may
- 8 appoint and deputize an assistant to be known as chief examiner, who
- 9 shall have charge and supervision of the division and who may, with the
- 10 approval of the state auditor, appoint and employ such state examiners
- 11 and clerical assistants as may be necessary to carry out the duties of
- 12 the division. In addition, the state auditor may contract with
- 13 certified public accountants certified in Washington to carry out such
