1 AN ACT Relating to the process for obtaining variances from the  
2 minor employment law; and amending RCW 26.28.060.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 26.28.060 and 1973 1st ex.s. c 154 s 39 are each  
5 amended to read as follows:

6 Every person who shall employ, and every parent, guardian or other  
7 person having the care, custody or control of such child, who shall  
8 permit to be employed, by another, any child under the age of fourteen  
9 years at any labor whatever, in or in connection with any store, shop,  
10 factory, mine or any inside employment not connected with farm or house  
11 work, without ((the)) a written permit ((thereto of a judge of a  
12 superior court of the county wherein such child may live)), shall be  
13 guilty of a misdemeanor.
