- 1 AN ACT Relating to railroad employee health and sanitation; and
- 2 amending RCW 81.40.095.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 81.40.095 and 1961 c 14 s 81.40.095 are each amended 5 to read as follows:
- 6 The utilities and transportation commission shall adopt and enforce
- 7 rules and regulations relating to sanitation and adequate shelter as it
- 8 affects the health of all railroad employees, including but not limited
- 9 to railroad trainmen, enginemen, yardmen, maintenance of way employees,
- 10 highway crossing watchmen, clerical, platform, freight house and
- 11 express employees. For the purpose of maintenance and cleaning of
- 12 running facilities, the commission shall specify terminals to have
- 13 servicing facilities.
- 14 The commission shall adopt and enforce rules to prohibit individual
- 15 railroad employees from working alone in the Cascade tunnel as it
- 16 <u>affects the health of railroad employees, including but not limited to</u>

- 1 controlling locomotives of trains, helper service locomotives, and
- 2 <u>maintenance personnel</u>.
