- (1) No person shall sell or permit to be sold any tobacco product 6
- through any device that mechanically dispenses tobacco products unless
- the device is located fully within premises from which minors are 8

- prohibited or in industrial worksites where minors are not employed and
- 10 not less than ten feet from all entrance or exit ways to and from each
- 11 premises.
- (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the board shall 12
- 13 adopt rules that allow an exception to the requirement that a device be
- 14 located not less than ten feet from all entrance or exit ways to and
- 15 from a premise under the following conditions: (a) If the device is
- fully visible at all times to the employee or employees within the 16
- premise who exercise control over the device; and (b) if it is 17
- physically impractical for the device to be located not less than ten 18
