1 AN ACT Relating to campaign financing and public disclosure for the
2 office of state treasurer; reenacting and amending RCW 42.17.2401; and
3 adding a new section to chapter 43.08 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.08 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 (1) A general partner of a limited partnership in which the state
8 investment board is a limited partner, a managing partner in a
9 partnership in which the state investment board has invested, or an
10 active money manager doing business with the state investment board may
11 not contribute, directly or indirectly, to any candidate for the office
12 of state treasurer or to any candidacy of the state treasurer.

13 (2) A candidate for the office of state treasurer may not knowingly
14 accept any contribution from: (a) A general partner of a limited
15 partnership in which the state investment board is a limited partner;
16 (b) a managing partner of a partnership in which the state investment
17 board has invested; or (c) an active money manager doing business with
18 the state investment board.

1 (3) The prohibitions in subsections (1) and (2) of this section do
2 not apply to contributions received from entities described in this
3 section doing business with the state investment board if all such
4 business was granted through a formal bid process.

5 **Sec. 2.** RCW 42.17.2401 and 1993 sp.s. c 2 s 18, 1993 c 492 s 488,
6 and 1993 c 281 s 43 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

7 For the purposes of RCW 42.17.240, the term "executive state
8 officer" includes:

9 (1) The chief administrative law judge, the director of
10 agriculture, the administrator of the office of marine safety, the
11 administrator of the Washington basic health plan, the director of the
12 department of services for the blind, the director of the state system
13 of community and technical colleges, the director of community, trade,
14 and economic development, the secretary of corrections, the director of

16 energy facility site evaluation council, the director of the energy
17 office, the secretary of the state finance committee, the director of
18 financial management, the director of fish and wildlife, the executive
19 secretary of the forest practices appeals board, the director of the
20 gambling commission, the director of general administration, the
21 secretary of health, the administrator of the Washington state health
22 care authority, the executive secretary of the health care facilities
23 authority, the executive secretary of the higher education facilities
24 authority, the executive secretary of the horse racing commission, the
25 executive secretary of the human rights commission, the executive
26 secretary of the indeterminate sentence review board, the director of
27 the department of information services, the director of the interagency
28 committee for outdoor recreation, the executive director of the state
29 investment board, the director of labor and industries, the director of
30 licensing, the director of the lottery commission, the director of the
31 office of minority and women's business enterprises, the director of
32 parks and recreation, the director of personnel, the executive director
33 of the public disclosure commission, the director of retirement
34 systems, the director of revenue, the secretary of social and health
35 services, the chief of the Washington state patrol, the executive
36 secretary of the board of tax appeals, (~~the director of trade and~~
37 ~~economic development,~~) the secretary of transportation, the secretary
38 of the utilities and transportation commission, the director of

1 veterans affairs, the president of each of the regional and state
2 universities and the president of The Evergreen State College, each
3 district and each campus president of each state community college;

7 trustees of each community college, each member of the state board for
8 community and technical colleges, state convention and trade center
9 board of directors, committee for deferred compensation, Eastern
10 Washington University board of trustees, Washington economic
11 development finance authority, The Evergreen State College board of
12 trustees, forest practices appeals board, forest practices board,
13 gambling commission, Washington health care facilities authority, each
14 member of the Washington health services commission, higher education
15 coordinating board, higher education facilities authority, horse racing
16 commission, state housing finance commission, human rights commission,
17 indeterminate sentence review board, board of industrial insurance
18 appeals, information services board, interagency committee for outdoor
19 recreation, state investment board, liquor control board, lottery
20 commission, marine oversight board, oil and gas conservation committee,
21 Pacific Northwest electric power and conservation planning council,
22 parks and recreation commission, personnel appeals board, board of
23 pilotage commissioners, pollution control hearings board, public
24 disclosure commission, public pension commission, shorelines hearing
25 board, public employees' benefits board, board of tax appeals,
26 transportation commission, University of Washington board of regents,
27 utilities and transportation commission, Washington state maritime
28 commission, Washington personnel resources board, Washington public
29 power supply system executive board, Washington State University board
30 of regents, Western Washington University board of trustees, and fish
31 and wildlife commission; and

32 (5) Within the office of the state treasurer the following
33 professional staff members: Assistant treasurer, deputy treasurer,
34 legal counsel, and investment officer.

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
