- 1 AN ACT Relating to school graduation incentives for recipients of
- 2 public assistance; and adding a new section to chapter 74.12 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 74.12 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Recipients of aid to families with dependent children are eligible
- 7 for a one-time monetary bonus scholarship per child above their aid to
- 8 families with dependent children grant if the school age child or
- 9 children of the parent, stepparent, relative, or guardian with whom the
- 10 child lives has a grade point average of 2.5 or above, graduates from
- 11 high school, and is enrolled at a postsecondary education institution.
- 12 The scholarship must be used by the family to directly support the
- 13 student's postsecondary education. The department shall report to the
- 14 appropriate standing committees of the state legislature by December 1,
- 15 1996, on the impact that the availability of the bonuses has on the
- 16 number of students graduating.
