- 1 AN ACT Relating to oil spill incident commander's liability;
- 2 amending RCW 88.44.180; and adding new sections to chapter 88.44 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 88.44.180 and 1990 c 117 s 19 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 Obligations incurred by the commission and any other liabilities or
- 7 claims against the commission shall be enforced only against the assets
- 8 of the commission, and no liability for the debts or actions of the
- 9 commission exists against either the state of Washington or any
- o commission exists against cremer the state of washington of any
- 10 subdivision or instrumentality thereof, or against any member, officer,
- 11 employee, incident commander, or agent of the commission in his or her
- 12 individual or representative capacity. Except as otherwise provided in
- 13 this chapter, neither the members of the commission, its officers,
- 14 agents, ((nor)) incident commander employees nor the business entities
- 15 by whom ((the members)) they are regularly employed may be held

- 7 commission, a member, officer, employee, incident commander, or agent
