1 AN ACT Relating to creation of a water resources board; adding a 2 new section to chapter 43.83B RCW; adding a new section to chapter 3 89.16 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 90.03 RCW; adding a new 4 section to chapter 90.14 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 90.16 5 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 90.22 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 90.24 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 90.38 RCW; adding a 6 7 new section to chapter 90.42 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 90.44 8 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 90.54 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 43.20 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 43.21A RCW; adding 9 new sections to chapter 43.27A RCW; adding a new section to chapter 10 11 43.99E RCW; adding a new section to chapter 90.08 RCW; creating new 12 sections; recodifying RCW 43.21A.067; decodifying RCW 90.14.043; repealing RCW 43.21A.170, 43.21A.180, 43.21A.190, 43.21A.200, and 13 14 43.21A.210; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature recognizes the growing importance of water resources to the citizens of the state of Washington. It is the purpose of this act to provide for a more effective and efficient program of managing and planning water

- 1 resources by creating a water resources board to administer a water
- 2 resources program that encompasses water right administration,
- 3 enforcement, well construction, adjudications, dam safety, data
- 4 management, policy and planning, program administration, and drought
- 5 activities.
- 6 It is further recognized that different areas of the state have
- 7 unique and differing needs and problems regarding water resources.
- 8 Therefore, it is the further purpose of this act to provide for greater
- 9 responsiveness and keener sensitivity to local needs and problems. In
- 10 order to concentrate efforts and to receive citizen input on these
- 11 local conditions the board shall be composed of persons from designated
- 12 areas of the state.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The water resources board is established.
- 14 The board has authority over water resources matters, however the water
- 15 resource program shall remain within the department of ecology. The
- 16 board shall exercise all powers and perform all duties relating to
- 17 water quantity matters prescribed by law including the management,
- 18 conservation, utilization, planning, development, and adjudication of
- 19 the state's water as provided in sections 7 through 22 of this act.
- 20 The board or its authorized designee shall represent itself in
- 21 legislative matters.
- The board shall appoint an administrator of water resources who
- 23 shall have authority to implement the decisions of the board. The
- 24 salary of the administrator shall be fixed by the governor in
- 25 accordance with RCW 43.03.040. The administrator shall serve at the
- 26 pleasure of the board. The assistant director of the office of water
- 27 and shorelands shall be an ex officio member of the board without a
- 28 vote. This section shall expire June 30, 2001.
- 29 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The board shall consist of five members,
- 30 appointed by the governor. The members shall be qualified electors and
- 31 residents of the geographic area under section 5 of this act. Members
- 32 must be knowledgeable and experienced in water resource matters in
- 33 areas in which the board has authority. All appointments and
- 34 reappointments, including those to fill vacancies, shall be confirmed
- 35 by the senate. The first members of the board shall be appointed by
- 36 the governor within sixty days after the effective date of this
- 37 section. The initial terms for board members from district one and

- district three shall expire on the first Thursday following the second Monday in January 1995, for board members from district two and district four shall expire on the first Thursday following the second Monday in January 1997, and for the board member from district five shall expire on the first Thursday following the second Monday in January 1999. Upon the expiration of the term of any member, the
- 7 governor shall appoint a suggessor for a term of five years. Vacancies
- 7 governor shall appoint a successor for a term of five years. Vacancies
- 8 on the board shall be filled by appointment made by the governor for
- 9 the unexpired term.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. The board shall meet at such times as it 10 deems advisable but at least once every month. It may adopt its own 11 12 rules and may establish its own procedures consistent with other provisions of state law. Resolutions or motions shall be adopted by a 13 14 vote of at least three members. The board may elect one of its members as chair for a term of one year. The chair may vote on all matters 15 Members of the board shall be compensated in 16 before the board. accordance with RCW 43.03.240 and shall receive reimbursement for their 17 18 travel expenses as provided in RCW 43.03.050 and 43.03.060.
- <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** The governor shall appoint one board member 19 20 from each of the following geographic areas: District one, Olympic Peninsula, shall include all of the land within Clallam, Jefferson, 21 22 Kitsap, Mason, Grays Harbor, Pacific, and Wahkiakum counties; district 23 two, Northwest Washington, shall include all of the land within 24 Whatcom, Skagit, Island, San Juan, Snohomish, and King counties; district three, Southwest Washington, shall include all of the land 25 within Skamania, Clark, Cowlitz, Lewis, Thurston, and Pierce counties; 26 27 district four, Central Washington, shall include Klickitat, Yakima, 28 Benton, Kittitas, Okanogan, Chelan, and Ferry counties; and district 29 five, Eastern Washington, shall include all of the land within Stevens, Pend Oreille, Douglas, Grant, Spokane, Lincoln, Walla Walla, Franklin, 30 31 Adams, Whitman, Garfield, Columbia, and Asotin counties.
- 32 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** The board shall have the following
- 33 functions, powers, and duties:
- 34 (1) Implement state water resources statutes through the adoption 35 of rules as necessary;

- 1 (2) Develop a comprehensive state water resource program by 2 developing and adopting regional water resource programs including the 3 establishment of instream flows in accordance with chapter 90.54 RCW;
- 4 (3) Develop proposals for statutory changes to the state water 5 resources statutes and submit these requested changes to the 6 legislature;
- 7 (4) Establish and implement programs and procedures for making 8 timely decisions for water right applications;
- 9 (5) Establish a mediation process that may be used to resolve water 10 right disputes;
- 11 (6) Develop and approve policies regarding enforcement and 12 regulation of water rights consistent with state laws and the 13 provisions of this chapter.

- 8 make a determination as to the proper allocation and certify the same
- 9 to the state agencies concerned.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 24.** All rules and all pending business before
- 11 the department of ecology relating to functions transferred shall be
- 12 continued and acted upon by the water resources board. All existing
- 13 contracts and obligations shall remain in full force and effect and
- 14 shall be performed by the water resources board.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 25.** Sections 2 through 6 of this act are each
- 16 added to chapter 43.27A RCW.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 26. RCW 90.14.043 is decodified.
- 18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 27.** The following acts or parts of acts are
