## SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 6539

State of Washington 53rd Legislature 1994 Regular Session

- 1 AN ACT Relating to the mandatory use of recycled paper; adding new
- 2 sections to chapter 2.28 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 34.05
- 3 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 44.04 RCW; creating a new section;
- 4 and providing an effective date.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that there is a need
- 7 to expand upon existing laws which foster the effective and efficient
- 8 management of solid waste by requiring that certain documents submitted
- 9 by attorneys at law to state courts of record be submitted on recycled
- 10 paper, and that legislative materials be prepared on recycled paper.
- 11 The legislature further finds that increased recycling will protect and
- 12 enhance the environment and economy of Washington state.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 2.28 RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the definitions in
- 16 this section apply throughout sections 2 through 4 of this act.
- 17 (1) "Attorney" means an attorney at law admitted to practice law
- 18 before any court of record in this state.

- 1 (2) "Document" means a pleading or other paper submitted as an 2 appendix to the pleading by an attorney, which document is required or 3 permitted to be filed with a clerk of court concerning an action to be 4 commenced or that is pending before a court of record.
- 5 (3) "Recycled paper" means paper with not less than fifty percent 6 of its total weight consisting of secondary and postconsumer waste and 7 with not less than ten percent of such total weight consisting of 8 postconsumer waste.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 2.28 RCW 10 to read as follows:
- (1) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, an attorney may not submit a document to a court of record after January 13 1, 1995, unless the document is submitted on recycled paper. This section applies to all papers appended to the document.
- 15 (2) Procedures adopted to implement this section may not impede 16 the conduct of court business nor create grounds for an additional 17 cause of action or sanction.
- 18 (3) A court of record may not refuse a document solely because the document was not submitted on recycled paper.
- 20 (4) This section does not apply to:
- 21 (a) A photograph;
- (b) An original document that was prepared or printed before January 1, 1995;
- 24 (c) A document that was not created at the direction or under the 25 control of the submitting attorney;
- (d) A facsimile copy otherwise permitted to be filed with a court of record in lieu of the original document. However, if the original is also required to be filed, the original must be submitted in compliance with this section; and
- 30 (e) Existing stock of nonrecycled paper and preprinted forms 31 acquired or printed before January 1, 1995.
- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 34.05 RCW to read as follows:
- 34 (1) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, an 35 attorney may not submit a document concerning an adjudicatory 36 proceeding after January 1, 1995, unless the document is submitted on

- 1 recycled paper. This section applies to all papers appended to the 2 document.
- 3 (2)(a) A state agency that adopts policies, procedures, rules, or 4 regulations for the purpose of implementing this section shall ensure 5 that the conduct of state business is not impeded and that a person is 6 not denied access to the services or programs of a state agency as a 7 result of the implementation.
- 8 (b) A state agency may not refuse a document solely because it was 9 not submitted on recycled paper.
- 10 (3) This section does not apply to:
- 11 (a) A photograph:
- 12 (b) An original document that was prepared or printed before 13 January 1, 1995;
- 14 (c) A document that was not created by the direction or under the 15 control of the submitting attorney;
- 16 (d) A facsimile copy concerning an adjudicatory proceeding 17 otherwise permitted to be filed in lieu of the original document.
- 18 However, if the original is also required to be filed, the original
- 19 must be submitted in compliance with this section; and
- 20 (e) Existing stock of nonrecycled paper and preprinted forms 21 acquired before January 1, 1995.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. A new section is added to chapter 44.04 RCW to read as follows:
- (1) After January 1, 1995, all printed materials produced by the senate and the house of representatives shall be printed on recycled paper.
- 27 (2) This section does not apply to:
- 28 (a) A photograph;
- 29 (b) Printed materials that were prepared or printed before January 30 1, 1995;
- 31 (c) Existing stock of nonrecycled paper and preprinted forms 32 acquired or printed before January 1, 1995.
- 33 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** This act shall take effect July 1, 1994.
