- 1 AN ACT Relating to the business and occupation taxation of moneys
- 2 received by health or social welfare organizations from governmental

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The 1993 health care reform act, chapter
- 7 492, Laws of 1993, established a business and occupation tax on
- 8 nonprofit and public hospitals to finance, in part, health care
- 9 coverage for the citizens of the state. However, by inadvertent error,
- 10 the health care reform act failed to address an existing deduction from
- 11 the business and occupation tax for governmental payments to nonprofit
- 12 organizations for health and social welfare services, such as federal
- 13 medicaid and medicare payments. Failure to correct this error will
- 14 result in revenues significantly less than those assumed by the
- 15 legislature in adopting the health care reform act and making
- 16 appropriations from the health services account. It is therefore the
- 17 intent of this act to clarify that revenues received by nonprofit and
- 18 public hospitals from governmental entities for health and social

- 1 services are subject to the business and occupation tax as intended by
- 2 chapter 492, Laws of 1993.
