1 BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate of the state of Washington, the House of Representatives concurring, That the Joint Legislative Systems 2 Committee shall provide members of the public with electronic access to 3 4 public legislative information such as the Revised Code of Washington, the Washington Administrative Code, the United States and Washington 5 State Constitutions, bills, bill digests, bill reports, calendars, 6 7 schedules, and resolutions. In carrying out this responsibility the 8 committee shall consider: The various data bases and documents maintained on the legislative information system; the desire by members 9 of the public for electronic access; the method and format best suited 10 for providing public access; the need to provide the most current and 11 12 accurate information; the educational purpose that would be served by granting public access; the need to maintain the integrity and security 13 14 of the legislative computer system; the capital and operating costs of 15 providing public access; and the desirability of providing access at no 16 cost to the general public. By October 1, 1994, the Joint Legislative 17 Systems Committee shall have adopted a plan for carrying out this resolution. 18
