- 6 (1) All causes of action by a person or persons against another

- The character of this section in the result in the character of the personal

representative shall only be entitled to recover damages for pain and

- 14 suffered by a deceased on behalf of those beneficiaries enumerated in
- 15 RCW 4.20.020, and such damages are recoverable regardless of whether or
- 16 not the death was occasioned by the injury that is the basis for the
- 17 action. The liability of property of a husband and wife held by them
- 18 as community property to execution in satisfaction of a claim
- 19 enforceable against such property so held shall not be affected by the

death of either or both spouses; and a cause of action shall remain an asset as though both claiming spouses continued to live despite the death of either or both claiming spouses.

(2) Where death or an injury to person or property, resulting from a wrongful act, neglect or default, occurs simultaneously with or after the death of a person who would have been liable therefor if his death had not occurred simultaneously with such death or injury or had not intervened between the wrongful act, neglect or default and the resulting death or injury, an action to recover damages for such death or injury may be maintained against the personal representative of such person.
