- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.08.350 and 1985 c 37 s 6 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) A certificate of registration shall be granted by the director
- 7 to all qualified applicants who are certified by the board as having

- 9 of completion of the required experience.
- 10 (2) Applications for examination shall be filed as the board

Nothing in this chapter prevents such a person from designing buildings for four years after July 28, 1992, or the five year period allowed for completion of the examination process, after that person has applied for registration. A person who has been designing buildings and is qualified under this subsection shall, upon application to the board of registration for architects, be allowed to take the examination for architect registration on an equal basis with other applicants)).
