- 9 (2) Have free access to all files and records of various funds
- 10 assigned to the department and inspect and audit the files and records
- 11 as deemed necessary;
- 12 (3) Employ personnel to carry out the general administration of the

- 14 (4) Submit an annual written report of the activities of the
- 15 department to the governor and the chairs of the appropriate
- 16 legislative committees with one copy to the staff of each of the
