- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 82.65A.030 and 1992 c 80 s 3 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 In addition to any other tax, a tax is imposed on every
- 7 intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded for the act or
- 8 privilege of engaging in business within this state. The tax is equal
- 9 to the gross income attributable to services for the mentally retarded,
- 10 multiplied by the rate of ((fifteen)) six percent.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 12 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 13 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 14 effect on such date as shall be certified by the secretary of social
- 15 and health services by which states must modify health care related

- 1 taxes to prevent the loss of federal medicaid participation in the cost
- 2 of the tax.
