- 6 The department of natural resources is authorized to offer and pay
- 7 a reward not to exceed ((one)) ten thousand dollars in each case for
- 8 information regarding violations of any statute or rule ((adopted
- 9 pursuant to any statute)) relating to the state's public lands and

- 11 and 79 RCW, and any rule adopted pursuant thereto)) on those lands,

to any federal, state, or local government or agency employees for
